APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

MIXING

Mix 1 bottle (1L) of Remover with approx. 5 liters of tepid water. Start with a small amount of water for the best mix-ability, and then add the rest. Mix well.

APPLICATION METHOD / TOOLS

Use sponge, brush or roller.

APPLICATION

- Apply plenty of the mixture to the wall, with a sponge, brush, or roller. Use rubber gloves.
- Let the mixture work for at least 15 minutes, however, the mixture must not dry. If the mixture dries, add water with a spray bottle or likewise.
- Then scrape the wallpaper with a steel trowel. If the wallpaper does not come off easily, repeat the process.
- When removing wallpaper with a non-absorbent outer layer, the surface must first be perforated with a pigg-/spike roller or possibly a steel brush.
- For vinyl wallpaper, remove the outer layer first, then apply the Casco® Remover.

CLEANING OF EQUIPMENT

On contact with the skin, wash off with soap and water. Clean tools with water.
